#### **About The Farm Project**

The Farm Project CIC (Community Interest Company) offers an unusual experience for children and young people through short-stay residentials on a working organic farm. Whilst here children and young people gain a deep understanding of where food comes from through hands-on growing, harvesting and cooking. They work with livestock and spend time in the woods building an awareness and appreciation for the natural world. Learning outside the classroom offers invaluable opportunities for personal development, building confidence and self-esteem. The nurturing environment encourages positive relationships to be built between individuals and gives a general sense of wellbeing.

### Job Description

The role is primarily working with residential stays though there will also be day visits from local groups as well as children's holiday clubs. The ideal candidate will be enthusiastic, friendly, outgoing and passionate about introducing young people to farm life. They will have experience of delivering education and working with children and young people from a diverse range of backgrounds. The candidate will genuinely enjoy the company of children and young people, be happy out in the woods whatever the weather and have a high mud tolerance.

## **Key responsibilities**

- To deliver inspiring cooking sessions focusing on seasonality and food from the farm
- To deliver education sessions with small groups of children, young people and occasionally adults including gardening, fire lighting, wood chopping, nature walks
- To provide a warm welcome to all visitors to the farm and to help generate an unforgettable environment
- To assist with the general housekeeping of the accommodation facilities including Friday changeovers
- To ensure safe and responsible working practice at all times, adhering to all The Farm Project policies and procedures

- Experience working with children and young people with social emotional difficulties, additional learning needs and disengaged young people
